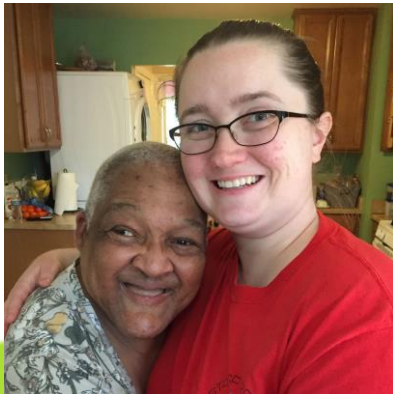




Annual Report 2021

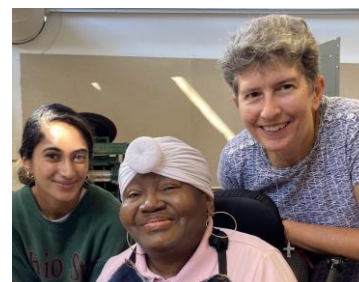

30 new donors joined our donor family

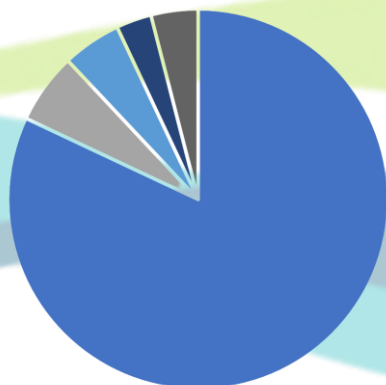
We received more than **\$6,900 annually** through monthly giving

Financial Snapshot

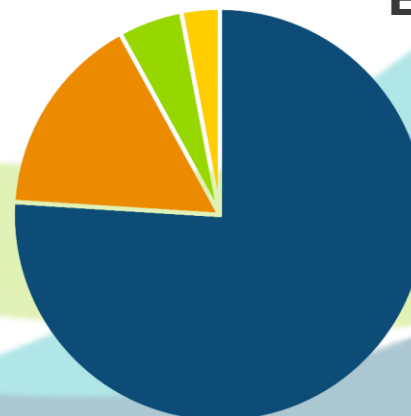
Revenue 2021
